For many years, The Building Congress & Exchange Foundation has been supportive of area high school students who have expressed an interest in construction careers. The Foundation will award The Future Craftsman Award to a select few area high school students who have demonstrated excellence in the carpentry, electrical, masonry, drafting and mechanical trades. In addition to peer recognition and a commemorative plaque, the finalists will receive a \$1,000 to be applied toward the cost of tuition for further education in construction or toward the purchase of tools to begin work in a construction career.

Applicants must be students enrolled in carpentry, electrical, masonry, drafting or mechanical trade; be a high school senior in 2020-2021 school year; and have a 95% attendance record and passing grades.

Applicants must submit the following information along with the completed application.

- Letter of recommendation from his/her technology education teacher
- Letter of recommendation from his/her principal
- Transcripts for the current & prior 2 years
- Proof of 95% attendance
- Proof of enrollment in either carpentry, masonry, electrical, drafting or mechanical trade.
